The Fight Against Infection Starts at Home

HOI Ambulatory Surgery Centers would like you to reduce your chances of acquiring a surgical site infection (SSI). Along with your surgeon, we ask that you please purchase chlorhexidine gluconate (CHG) soap and a nasal antiseptic to utilize before surgery. Use the CHG soap once a day and the nasal antiseptic twice a day.



Chlorhexidine Gluconate (CHG) Soap

CHG soap can be purchased at most pharmacies and online.

Chlorhexidine Gluconate (CHG) Shower Instructions

Bath with chlorhexidine gluconate (CHG) antiseptic soap <u>5 times</u> before your surgery. <u>Start 4 nights before</u> your surgery, the last shower will be the morning of surgery.

- 1. If you are going to wash your hair and face, WASH them FIRST with your shampoo and face soap.
- 2. Thoroughly rinse your hair, face, and body with water.
- 3. Stand away from the shower stream and apply CHG from your neck to your toes avoiding your genitals. Leave soap on body for 2 minutes. DO NOT use CHG anywhere above your neck (i.e., eyes, nose, ears, mouth).
- 4. Rinse.
- 5. Dry off with a CLEAN TOWEL.
- 6. DO NOT USE any lotions or powders. You may use deodorant.
- 7. Put on CLEAN CLOTHES OR PAJAMAS.
- 8. Clean bed sheets the night before surgery.
- 9. Remember to REPEAT the STEPS for each shower.
